

# Championship Conditions

## Swedish Seniors Open Golf Championship Royal Drottningholm Golf Club July 23, 24 and 25, 2012

- 1) The official time is the clock on the first tee.
- 2) If play is suspended (i.e. risk for lightning) by signal from the Championship Committee, the player shall suspend/discontinue and proceed in accordance with Rule 6-8b (mark the ball or finish the hole without delay). *Play will, at the earliest, be resume after 30 minutes.*
- 3) The player after the round shall leave the score card to the Committee at the desk/table on the terrace in front of the scoring board. The score card is considered returned to the Committee once the player leaves the desk/table.
- 4) Championship is stroke play over three rounds and is played in accordance with the approved Rules of Golf, regulations for competition (SGF) and the Local Rules.
- 5) The course is Drottningholm, par 72, white 6 300 meters, yellow tee 5 900 meters, red 4 900 meters.
- 6) The Championship is played from the white and yellow tees for Men and blue and red tees for Ladies.
- 7) All players play one round on Monday and one round on Tuesday. There will be a cut after 36 holes to be decided. The third and final round is on Wednesday.
- 8) In the event of a tie after 3 rounds the winner of the Championship is decided by sudden-death.
- 9) To be decided, best eight Men's scores and the best five Ladies scores receive prizes immediately after the Championship. The best Man having reached the age of 65 years before December 31, 2012 receives a prize. Prizes are in accordance with the amateur rules.
- 10) Male entrants shall have reached the age of 35 respectively 55 years before December 31, 2012. Ladies entrants shall have reached the age of 35 respectively 50 years before December 31, 2012.
- 11) The Championship Fee is 800 SEK. International player may pay upon arrival.
- 12) Referees decision is in accordance with Rule 34-2 final.
- 13) The Championship Committee reserves the right to amend the Rules or Conditions, should it be considered necessary, and to make a decision in Equity in accordance with the Rules of Golf. The Championship Committee also reserves the right to cancel any round, to suspend the competition or to modify the form of play.
